F.	During Summer Term , a flat tuition fee of Rs.5000/- per credit would be chargeable from a B.Tech, M.Tech (without Institute fellowship) and PGDIIT student, and Rs.500/- per credit (including equivalent thesis units) from the students in other programmes. In addition, Hostel Seat rent and utility charges will be lump sum Rs.4000/- for entire summer term. Messing and laundry charges would be as per actuals.				
G.	Fee for Non-Degree student will be same as other students of IITGN in that programme unless there is a formal agreement between IITGN and the Institute/ University for student exchange programme. In such case, the terms and conditions of the agreement will prevail. The security deposit for non-degree students will be Rs.10000/-.				
H.	For Part Time Non-Degree student , a flat tuition fee of Rs.5000/- per credit registered will be chargeable. The security deposit for such students will be Rs.10000/-.				

For 2013, 2014 and 2015 batch B.Tech students, the tuition fee will continue to be Rs.45000/- per semester and Rs.25000/- per semester for students of batches prior to 2013.

Notes:

1. SC, ST and PwD (with 40% minimum disability) students in regular programme (including Summer term) will be eligible for waiver of tuition fee.
2. Students not residing in hostels and not availing mess facilities would be exempted from paying C.3, C.4, C.5, C.6 and D.
3. The most economically backward B.Tech students of 2016 batch onwards (whose family income is less than Rs. 1 lakh per annum) shall get full remission of the Tuition Fee.
4. The other economically backward B.Tech students of 2016 batch onwards (whose family income is between Rs. 1 lakh to Rs. 5 lakh per annum) shall get remission of 2/3rd of the Tuition Fee.

NORMS AND FEES FOR ISSUE OF TRANSCRIPT AND GRADE REPORTS

Presently, the Institute is issuing Grade Reports and Transcripts to its students and its alumnus without any charges and limitation in number of copies. However, considering that the Institute has expanded to sizeable strength and total number of students including alumnus has crossed 1300 number, the need is felt to introduce a set procedure and introduce reasonable charges for this service provided to them. This proposal will not become hurdle for any student who may not afford to pay the charges (because it may be waived on case to case basis) but it will certainly put a break or at least minimize misuse.

Accordingly, the following proposal, which is in line with IIT Bombay norms, is submitted for consideration and approval, please:

1) For Graduating Students/Alumnus:

- A. Two complimentary copies of transcript will be issued to graduating students once they complete graduation requirements.
- B. Rs.200/- (Rupees Two hundred only) will be charged for every additional copy of transcript.
- C. Students making request for transcript by post should pay additional postage of Rs.300/- within India and Rs.1000/- for posting abroad irrespective of number of sets, provided it is to be posted in a single envelope. In case multiple address, the charges will multiply.
- D. The charges for those who are applying for the transcripts from abroad will be \$50 per set irrespective of the year of graduation plus \$50 for postage charges.

2) For On-Roll Students:

- A. One complimentary copy of transcript will be issues at the end of every Semester to the students of B.Tech from third year onwards and PG (M.Tech, M.Sc. & M.A.) from second year onwards.
- B. Rs. 200/- (Rupees Two hundred only) will be charged for every additional copy of transcript. This will also be applicable for issue of duplicate Semester Grade Report.

A rubber stamp of DUPLICATE will be put on all the additional copies of transcripts and grade reports.

The above charges can be paid by cash to Accounts Office of IIT Gandhinagar or by way of direct deposit/e-transfer/demand draft in favour of IIT Gandhinagar Main Account.
